


## Ideas to Share





### **Small Adapted Car**



Film canisters may be used to create easy hold grips for many items. They are available free from any store that does film processing.

#### **Materials:**

Discarded 35 mm film canister Hot glue Small car

#### **Directions:**

Hot glue the top cover of the film canister to the roof of the car.

#### Implementation:

The film canister is attached for the young child who may be unable to propel the car without a handle. The bottom of the canister may be removed for the child who does not require the "handle" without interfering with the car's function.
