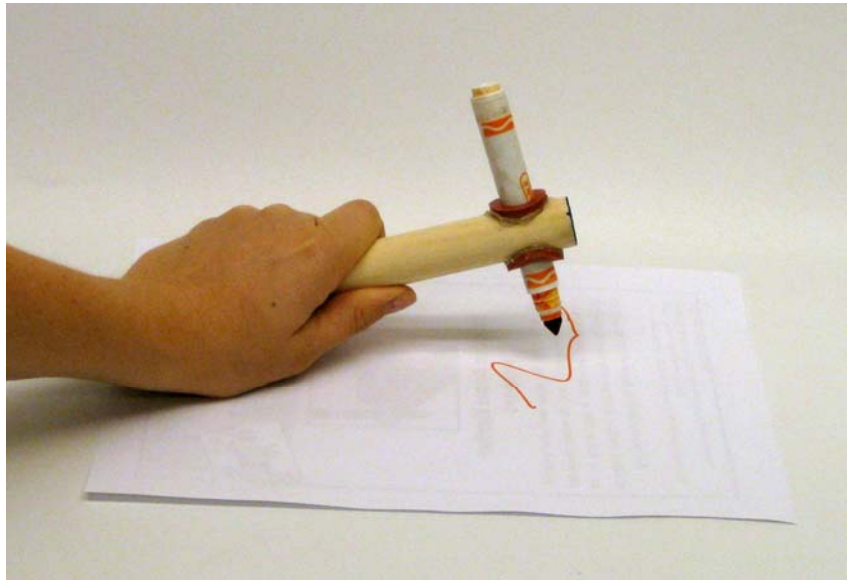


Ideas to Share



Wooden Dowel Marker Support



Drill a half-inch hole into a wooden dowel, insert a marker, add two rubber washers to keep the marker secure and increase student participation in name writing or art assignments. Add a marker with letter or number stamps so student can practice writing the alphabet or counting.
