## Book Reading: Staying on Task



For children that have difficulty attending to a task, book reading can become very frustrating and difficult. To make a book of the child's favorite things or pictures use a camera, notebook, page protectors and white paper. Start with the child's favorite things, i.e. stuffed animal, toy, blanket, Mom, Dad, Grandma, etc. Take a picture of the item or person. Paste the picture onto the page with the name of the item printed in bold, large print under the picture. Put a page protector over the page and put it in the binder. Make a book of 5 to 10 items. If necessary, combine this with page fluffers to help the child turn the pages of the book. Read the book with the child pointing out his/her favorite items.
